Minutes: Minutes approved from October meeting.

Treasurer's Report: All candy sale moneys are in and quarterly bills are paid. Treasurer's report approved.

President's Report: Once again, Home and School gave \$30 gift certificates to all the teachers for Christmas. Laurie passed the "Thank you" notes for all to read.

Principal's Report:

Gym Floor: Home and School to pay \$2659 to Baseman Bros. for the gym floor. The floor will be completely refinished again this summer due to problems with previous job. The cost to St. Charles is \$3500 which is 1/3 the normal price.

Textbooks: The new reading textbooks have supplementary level books which Home and School purchased at a cost of \$4000. These included level books for 2nd grade. We will purchase the new textbooks for 2nd grade next year.

Candy Sales Reward: The school reward for candy sales was a movie with popcorn and soda at the Plaza Theatre. The reward was enjoyed by both students and staff.

Catholic Schools Week: Classes will draw to see who will participate in the pig races. Pizza and limo will be provided to top sellers on Wednesday February 2nd.

Radio Disney: St. Charles qualified for a Radio Disney Dance Party which will be held on February 23rd for Kindergarten thru 5th grade. Radio Disney will also participate in next year's High Interest Day.

Athletics: Sister Margaret asked Home and School to assist with the purchase of uniforms if Athletics finds their committee falling short. We will know by the end of the school year.

New Business:

Special Interest Day: Judy requested help from Home & School members. She will send out sign-up information.

-Home & School will again spend \$10/gift for presenters.

-Sister will confirm Subway lunch with Mario DeNoto. St. Charles will also provide soup and volunteers are needed to make desserts.

Pig Roast: The first Pig Roast meeting is Tuesday, January 11th. Suzy Bittmann is looking for someone to replace her in the task of organizing the class prize baskets. It was also recommended that we make a pdf. file with the basket prizes in attempt to sell more tickets. Ticket sales will remain at \$1/ticket.

Pizza Sale: Pizza sale sold \$9500 worth of pizza, which indicates that parents are continuing to use this Washington D.C. trip fundraiser. There was inquiry if there would be a second sale.
